Scriptural Definition

of the Tithe


The Bible speaks of the fithe as a standard for giving. The tithe is defined as the first ten percent of our earnings, returned to God and the work of the church. This is difficult for some, and others have grown in their generosity well beyond this biblical standard.

Growing in the grace of giving is a worthy, God honoring goal to consider each year. Your intentional decision to give in proportion to your resources will enable you to accomplish your personal, good steward goal.


Our gifts help to create and implement ministries that change lives, transform communities, and spread the good news of Christ.
