TRANSFORMED!

A KEY TO UNDERSTANDING WHAT IT MEANS TO BE A CHRISTIAN IS ST. PAUL'S APPEAL IN ROMANS 12:2—: "DO NOT BE CONFORMED TO THE PRESENT AGE, BUT BE TRANSFORMED BY THE RENEWING OF YOUR MINDS, SO THAT YOU MAY DISCERN WHAT IS THE GOOD AND ACCEPTABLE AND PERFECT WILL OF GOD." TO PUT IT BRIEFLY: WE FOLLOWERS OF JESUS CHRIST SHOULD NOT BE CONFORMED, BUT WE ARE TO BE TRANSFORMED!

LIKE SOME OF YOU, PERHAPS, MY UPBRINGING MADE ME KEENLY AWARE OF "WORLDLINESS." I WAS TAUGHT, BOTH BY MY PARENTS AND MY HOME CHURCH, THAT I SHOULD AVOID EVERYTHING "WORLDLY," INCLUDING THE SALOON, THE MOVIE THEATER, THE DANCE HALL, AND THE POOL PARLOR; CARDS AND GAMBLING; ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO; AND, OF COURSE, SWEARING AND CURSING. THOUGH MY VIEW OF SOME OF THESE HABITS HAS CHANGED OVER THE YEARS, I STILL I DESIRE TO LIVE BY THE VALUES OF GOD'S KINGDOM RATHER THAN THE VALUES OF THIS WORLD! AS A CHRISTIAN BELIEVER, I DO NOT WANT MY THINKING AND CONDUCT TO BE CONFORMED TO THE PATTERN OF THE PRESENT AGE. I STILL APPRECIATE—AND ACCEPT!—THE CHALLENGE TO LIVE BY THE VALUES OF HEAVEN, NOT THOSE OF THIS EARTH. I HOPE THAT EVEN MY THINKING WILL BE TRANSFORMED AND TRANSFORMATIONAL.

MANY TEXTS AND STORIES IN THE BIBLE GIVE US GUIDANCE. THE APOSTLE PETER IS A PRIME EXAMPLE: EVEN AS ONE OF THE DISCIPLES, HE CONTINUES TO THINK AND ACT IN CONFORMITY WITH THE VALUES OF HIS TIME AND PLACE. HE BOLDLY AFFIRMS JESUS AS THE EXPECTED MESSIAH (MATTHEW 16:16), BUT HE ARGUES WITH JESUS HIMSELF ABOUT HIS MESSIANIC ROLE (MATTHEW 16:21-23). THE FOURTH GOSPEL REPORTS THAT PETER REVERES AND EVEN TRIES TO PROTECT JESUS (JOHN18:10-11), BUT HE IS STILL THINKING AND LIVING ACCORDING TO THE RULES SET BY THE JEWISH LEADERS: FOLLOWING JESUS'S ARREST, PETER IS IN THE HIGH PRIEST'S COURTYARD "STANDING WITH THEM" (18:18), AND WHEN "THEY" CONFRONT HIM, HE ACTUALLY DENIES JESUS (18:25-27)! IS THIS THE SAME PETER, PREACHING THE FIRST CHRISTIAN SERMON IN ACTS 2:14-36 WITH TRANS-FORMATIONAL EFFECT (2:41)? CAN IT BE THE SAME MAN WHO (WITH HIS COMPANION, JOHN), NOW MYSTIFIES THE JEWISH AUTHORITIES BECAUSE HE, A COMMON, ORDINARY MAN REFUSES TO BE CONFORMED TO THEIR RULES (ACTS 4:13)? YES, THE SAME! EXCEPT PETER NOW IS NOT CONFORMING! NO, HE IS TRANSFORMED IN HIS WAY OF THINKING AND TRANSFORMATIONAL IN HIS CONDUCT AND INFLUENCE!

IN HIS BOOK THE WEIGHT OF GLORY, C. S. LEWIS WROTE: "THERE IS NO QUESTION OF A COMPROMISE BETWEEN THE CLAIMS OF GOD AND THE CLAIMS OF CULTURE, OR POLITICS, OR ANYTHING ELSE. GOD'S CLAIM IS INFINITE AND INEXORABLE." ONE IS EITHER CONFORMED TO THE PRESENT AGE OR TRANSFORMED BY THE WILL OF GOD. THERE IS NO MIDDLE WAY! EACH OF US IS STILL INVOLVED IN MANY ORDINARY, MUNDANE, DAY-TO-DAY ACTIVITIES, BUT THE TRANSFORMATIONAL DISTINCTION COMES WHEN WE THINK, WITH PAUL, "WHETHER YOU EAT OR DRINK...DO ALL TO THE GLORY OF GOD " (1 CORINTHIANS 10:31, COMPARE 6:12-20).

AND THERE IS NOTHING BETTER, EITHER IN THIS AGE OR IN THE AGE TO COME, THAN THINKING AND LIVING IN THE CENTER OF GOD'S WILL!


