Jesus Gives Us Courage

Scripture: Matthew 14:22-33

Fear is the opposite of trusting God. Worry produces fear, fear produces bondage, and bondage prevents people from experiencing God's best in their lives.

FEAR: (Webster's dictionary) "an unpleasant emotion caused by anticipation or awareness of danger; anxious concern; reason for alarm."

What fear does to people and Churches?

- ...Cripples people.
- ...Stops progress (in God's mission)
- ...Prevents new possibilities.
- ...Poisons spiritual growth.

Fear can hold people ...

- Hostage Locked into past-memories.
- > from developing God-given talents
- from trying new things
- > from knowing people
- > from getting places (Peter going across the lake)
- from spiritual commitments

Peter had COURAGE: (Matthew 14:28-30)

- More faith than the other eleven disciples. (He got out of the boat)
- Peter experienced "water walking."
- Peter was willing to try the "Him-possible."

COURAGE: "mental or moral strength to venture, persevere - withstand difficulty, danger and fear."

<u>Matthew 14:27</u> "(27) ...Jesus spoke to them saying, 'Be of good cheer! It is I; **Do not be** <u>afraid</u>." <u>AFRAID</u>: (<u>Gk</u>: phobeó): "to fear, to terrify, withdraw from (flee), avoid."

What Peter did RIGHT? (Vv. 25-29)

- 1) Peter TESTED Jesus "(28) 'Lord, if it is you,' Peter replied, 'tell me to come to you on the water.""
- **2)** <u>Peter TRUSTED Jesus</u> "(29) 'Come,' he said, 'Then **Peter got down out of the boat**, walked on the water and came toward Jesus.'"
- 3) Peter kept his EYES ON Jesus "(29) ...walked on the water and came toward Jesus."

What Peter did WRONG? (Vv. 30-33)

- 1) His eyes wandered OFF Jesus "(30) But when he saw the wind, he was afraid..."
- 2) FEAR entered his mind "(30) ...and, beginning to sink, cried out, 'Lord, save me!'"
- **3)** <u>He thought APART from Jesus not with Jesus</u> "(31) Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. 'You of little faith,' he said, 'why did you doubt?'"

This story teaches us...

- Our "eyes" can quickly be taken off Jesus.
- Christians can let "natural fears" instill fear into our faith.
- Christians can have a "faith failure" when our eyes are off Jesus.

"Fear is easier than faith – because fear controls the outcome called familiarity – however dysfunctional it may be." (Pastor Jerry Ernst)

- 2) What is Jesus prompting you to step out into, by faith?
