FREDERICKTOWN INTERCHURCH JAN – JUNE 2025 UPDATE
Here are the Interchurch stats / updates for the first half of 2025, we've been busy so far this year.
Food Pantry; 175 households = 493 individuals = 4,437 meals.
Financial Aid assistance:
Utilities; electric – 13 households, water – 3 households; gas – 5 households; phone – 1
Vouchers; clothing – 11 households = 47 individuals; gasoline – 4 households
Misc.; Wood delivery – 1 household, car repair – 2 household
Total Financial Aid dollars = approx. \$10,696.69
Interchurch also gave a monetary donation to Fredericktown Schools to help with past due school lunch fees so Seniors could graduate and also towards the Washington D.C. field trip so all students could go.
As in previous years, Interchurch provided summer meals and school supplies for students of our clients = 50 children.
Fredericktown Interchurch is the only branch within the county that provides these programs and that is due to the monetary generosity of the Fredericktown Community.
We are in need of taxable items for our Food Pantry such as laundry detergent (prefer laundry sheets-easy to store), dish soap (small bottles), cleaning products (wipes, window cleaner, toilet bowl cleaner, all-purpose spray cleaner, paper towels...) liquid hand and shower soap, feminine pads (no tampons).
