### 1. EVENT COORDINATOR

The On-Call Event Coordinator provides event-specific support for weddings, funerals, memorial services, and occasional church or facility-use events. The coordinator ensures basic logistics and facility needs are addressed so events are conducted smoothly, respectfully, and with aligned values of the church. Hours are event-based and not guaranteed. Scheduling is dependent on weddings, funerals, and other approved events. The position is accountable to the Pastor-Parish Relations Committee.

### 2. BUILDING ADMINISTRATOR

The Building Administrator is an hourly, part-time position (anticipated 10–15 hours per week, varying weekly) requiring a flexible schedule. This role is responsible for managing daily building- and grounds-related operations in coordination with the Church Pastor, staff, committees, volunteers, members, and the community. The ability to build strong relationships and work seamlessly with others is essential to the success of this position. The position is accountable to the Pastor-Parish Relations Committee.
